




# Home Mission Update



**If WEBA churches gave £240,000 (as they did in 2014) this is how it would be used in 2016:**

£118,000 (49%) would go to local churches and other mission projects within WEBA as Home Mission grants



£119,486 (50%) would come back to WEBA as our core funding

£2,514 (1%) would remain to support the rest of our Union


