How have you grown / developed in your leadership role through and since Invest?

Leading ABC through the last two and a half years has been the most amazing blessing, we have grown in membership and have more regular attendees we have become a charity including updating constitution and all policies, I have project managed a £65k renovation and successfully written grant bids for most of

these funds so our prayerfully led plans will soon be possible.

We now have a screen, speakers and mixer to screen online service talks and music enabling us to worship completely without physical help from Cirencester (using their

talks). During lockdowns we were visible in the community and put on outside events at Christmas and Easter for the community with a Christian message. None of this would have happened without the skills and confidence I gained from Invest that I now pass onto my team.

I have taken 2 weddings and a funeral they all went really well, God is great. I have a regular mentor for myself and I mentor our single youth member who recently with help from us and CBC led a youth service in the parish church in our village where 100 plus came to the service usually they get a dozen it was amazing.

I am so excited for the future, we may be a small church but we are prayerful and God is walking with us every step. We never look down, we trust he has bigger things for us.

How have you personally grown as a disciple of Jesus through Invest? I have changed and continue to do so, I have far more confidence in God and understand more and more what Jesus did for me.

I'm starting to feel confident in my identity as a Christian whereas before I hid my faith rather than speak in case I drew (what I considered bad attention), now I am proud to speak up as I feel I have better tools, before I couldn't confidently answer the big questions.

Spiritually learning through reading (bible and books recommended for me) has really helped me grow.

My support network my mentor whom I met at the Webnet conference, CBC staff and Cotswold cluster ministers plus Webnet have all been there throughout. Prayer has become a much bigger thing in my life reaping rewards far outweighing my efforts, I feel very blessed that Invest has enabled all this to happen in the name of Jesus.
